

## **Senior Investment Analyst**

*As a senior member of the Myanmar Investments Limited ("MIL") private equity investment team based in Yangon you will be responsible for evaluating, structuring, closing and monitoring investments.*

### **Primary Responsibilities**

1. To lead a team of analysts in running private equity style investments including:
  - a. Conducting preliminary assessment and evaluation of investment opportunities.

2. To mentor and train the existing investment team (Myanmar nationals) on deal evaluation and execution.
3. Other duties as assigned.
